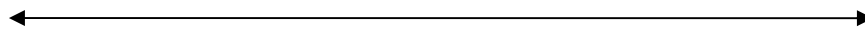


Somerset Community College
2007-2008 Planning Initiatives
Developed by the College Planning Team November 16-17, 2006
Lake Cumberland State Resort Park

- PI-1 Increase student access by 10% over previous academic year to “in demand coursework/training” of credit/non-credit hours generated by alternative offerings (ITV, KYVU, KET, evening, bi-terms, 14-week classes, weekends and summer offerings.) (56 – *ST Accessibility*)
- PI-2 Improve student access by increasing the fall-to-fall retention rate of first-time, credential seeking students to 65%. (35 – *ST Accessibility*)
- PI-3 Equip 100% of college buildings with reliable wireless access technology. (35 – *ST Communication*)
- PI-4 Increase academic unit/division budgets by an average of 10%. (22 – *ST Leadership*)
- PI-5 Develop a college technology plan to support teaching and learning as measured by a baseline faculty assessment of current and reliable instructional technology. (21 – *ST Learning Environment*)
- PI-6 Develop leadership skills in faculty and staff by providing one leadership seminar for each group. (14 – *ST Learning Environment*)
- PI-7 Adopt a culture of evidence that integrates student outcomes CAP team findings with at least one documented improvement strategy in each academic program and/or general education course. (6 – *ST Learning Environment*)
- PI-8 Assess community perception of the quality of SCC programs and services via sampling survey techniques. (6 – *ST Communication*)
- PI-9 Increase enrollment by 3% through the use of an integrated marketing team. (6 – *ST Communication*)
- PI-10 Increase news coverage for London and eastern district counties by 10% compared to 2006-07 level as measured by the number of media articles published. (6 – *ST Communication*)
- PI-11 Improve the learning environment and student access by exceeding the Kentucky Plan goal targets in all four categories. (5 – *ST Leadership*)
- PI-12 Improve internal communications to 65% of administration, faculty and staff respondents to the Campus Climate Survey agreeing they are satisfied with the extent to which information is shared between divisions/departments. (2 – *ST Communication*)
