

Narrative Film Judging Criteria

The Narrative Film is designed to use continuity style filmmaking techniques to tell a story.

Cinematography. How well was the camera used in terms of angles, shot size, exposure, color, imagery and special film effects?

Screenplay. How well was the story written?

Audio. How well did the audio display clarity and modulation in its reinforcement of the ideas of the story? How effective was the soundtrack?

Directing. How well was the story presented? Did it clearly deliver its message?

Editing. How well did the composition of the film deliver the story?

Acting. How effective were the actors in presenting their characters in the service of the film's story?

Overall Effect. How well did all of the elements of the film work together to deliver the story?
